SOCIOLOGY

For the first year of study, the students of all the three departments follow the same major courses, but starting with the second year of study there are specific major courses for every specialty, including the elective courses. The sociology undergraduate curriculum is designed to provide students with a solid grounding in classical and contemporary social theory, to introduce them to the key themes

and methods of sociological analysis and to enable them to pursue particular subjects and topics. The curriculum is meant to provide a cumulative understanding both of the numerous dimensions of modern social life and of the distinctive theories and methods that have come to define the sociological approach. Here are the main undergraduate courses in Sociology: social problems, statistical methods in social sciences, social psychology, socio-anthropology of family, stratification and social stratification, sociology of education, social communication.

The Social Work Department is centered on specific problems of nowadays society. Here are some of the most important course topics: Methodology and Theories of Social Work, Legislation in Social Work, Deviance and Social Control, Prevention and Reinstatement of Drug and Alcohol Addicts, Child Protection, Social Work for the Elderly, Notions of Psychopathology (Psychiatry) and Mental Health, Management of Social Services, and Programs of Assistance, Adoption and Family Placement, Individual Rehabilitation.

The academic and field practicum components are designed to teach professional social work knowledge and to impart tools for critical thinking and evidenced based practice. All the teaching staff is committed to ethical practice and to the integration of social work values in all educational activities and practice. The purpose of undergraduate education is to prepare students to work in entry-level agency based social work positions.
