Professional profile

Solid academic activity, with full compliance with and substantial exceeding of the national standards for habilitation in Sociology. The total score accumulated under the CNATDCU indicators is 1,477 points, compared to the minimum required threshold of 150 points, including 159.4 points for WoS/ISI articles (11) and 11 original articles published in international peer-reviewed journals. The editorial portfolio includes one book as sole author and six volumes as first author or editor. After obtaining the doctoral degree, 1,450.6 points were accumulated, reflecting sustained research activity, publication output, and scientific coordination.

Evaluations of teaching activity in 2024-2025

The overall average of student evaluations in the most recent academic year is 4.46, above the faculty average (4.36) and above the minimum eligibility threshold (3.5). By course, the average scores are as follows: Urban Sociology: 4.75; Labor Management: 4.50; Data View: 4.00.
